

**Statement Regarding the Registration, Evaluation, Authorization  
and Restriction of Chemicals (REACH)**

**Brand Name:** Zotac

**Date:** November 21, 2025

REACH (Registration, Evaluation, Authorization and Restriction of Chemical substances) is an European Community Regulation on chemicals and their safe use (EC 1907/2006). The regulation entered into force on June 1st 2007.

To the best of our knowledge, the product with a “ZT-”, “ZBOX-”, “ZBOXNANO-”, “ZP”, “MEK”, “P250”, “P288”, “9288”, “188-”, “288-”, “28A-”, “299-”, “250-”, “9250-” or “928A-” prefix in the full part number of Zotac products indicates that a product does not contain any of the 250 substances on the SVHC candidate list in concentrations greater than 0.1% by weight per article, except Lead (CAS No. 7439-92-1) or 1,2-dimethoxyethane; ethylene glycol dimethyl ether (EGDME) (CAS No. 110-71-4) may be presented in some components (ie. IC or coin battery).
